PRIVACY POLICY

Keeping your personal information safe.

Marshall Fine Art Editions hold the privacy of your personal information in the highest regard and complies with Australian privacy legislation in the way it collects, uses, secures and discloses your personal information.

What Information Do We Collect?

We lawfully collect personal information that is necessary for our business to function. The information we collect and hold will depend upon the products and services you request from us and may include two types of information:

Personal information you knowingly choose to disclose that is collected on an individual basis and

Website use information collected on an aggregate basis as you and others browse the website.

1. Personal Information You Choose to Provide:

Registration Information:

When you register for any of our products, services or newsletters you will knowingly provide us information about yourself. This information may include your name, and contact details such as email address, phone number and mailing address.

Credit Card Information:

If you choose to avail of our services, you may need to give personal information and authorization to obtain information from various credit services. For example, you may need to provide the following information, this can be done securely through Paypal, by phone or email.

- Name
- Mailing address
- Email address
- Credit card number
- Name on credit card

- Credit card billing address
- Business and home phone number

How Do We Use the Information That You Provide to Us?

I will not use your personal information for any other purpose without first seeking your consent, unless authorized or required by law. Generally your personal information will be only used to:

- To establish and maintain your relationship as a customer of Marshall Fine Art Editions.
- To provide the products and services you have requested from Marshall Fine art Editions.
- To answer your inquiry.
- Occasionally, to notify you about important changes to my Website/s, new products, and special offers I think you will find valuable. You may notify me at any time if you do not wish to receive these offers by emailing me at the link provided on the newsletter and you will be removed from my mailing list.

Your personally identifiable information or business information will not be shared with other parties except as required by law.

2. Web Site Use Information

Similar to other commercial Web sites, our Web site utilizes a standard technology called "cookies" (see explanation below, "What Are Cookies?") and web server log files to collect information about how our Web site is used. Information gathered through cookies and Web server logs may include the date and time of visits, the pages viewed, time spent at our Web site, and the Web sites visited just before and just after our Web site.

What Are Cookies?

A cookie is a very small text document, which often includes an anonymous unique identifier. When you visit a Web site, that site's computer asks your computer for permission to store this file in a part of your hard drive specifically designated for cookies. Each Web site can send its own cookie to your browser if your browser's preferences allow it, but (to protect your privacy) your browser only permits a Web site to access the cookies it has already sent to you, not the cookies sent to you by other sites. Browsers are usually set to accept cookies. However, if you would prefer not to receive cookies, you may alter the configuration of your browser to refuse cookies. If you choose to have your browser refuse cookies, it is possible that some areas of our site will not function as effectively when viewed by the users. A cookie cannot retrieve any other data from your hard drive or pass on computer viruses.

How Do We Use Information We Collect from Cookies?

As you visit and browse our Web site, the site uses cookies to differentiate you from other users. Cookies, in conjunction with our Web server's log files, allow us to calculate the aggregate number of people visiting our Web site and which parts of the site are most popular. This helps us gather feedback to constantly improve our Web site and better serve our clients. Cookies do not allow us to gather any personal information about you and we do not intentionally store any personal information that your browser provided to us in your cookies.

IP Addresses

IP addresses are used by your computer every time you are connected to the Internet. Your IP address is a number that is used by computers on the network to identify your computer. IP addresses are automatically collected by our web server as part of demographic and profile data known as traffic data so that data (such as the Web pages you request) can be sent to you.

How Can You Access and Correct Your Information?

You may request access to all your personally identifiable information by emailing us at the usual address. If you would like to check or amend your contact details, please contact us.

What About Legally Compelled Disclosure of Information?

We may disclose information when legally compelled to do so, in other words, when we, in good faith, believe that the law requires it or for the protection of our legal rights. We may also disclose account information when we have reason to believe that disclosing this information is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who may be violating our Terms of Service or to protect the safety of our users and the Public.

What About Other Web Sites Linked to Our Web Site?

We are not responsible for the practices employed by Web sites linked to or from our Web site or the information or content contained therein. Often links to other Web sites are provided solely as pointers to information on topics that may be useful to the users of our Web site.

Please remember that when you use a link to go from our Website to another web site, our Privacy Policy is no longer in effect. Your browsing and interaction on any other web site, including web sites, which have a link on our Website, is subject to that Web site's own rules and policies. Please read over those rules and policies before proceeding.

The Internet is not always a secure method of transmitting information. Accordingly, Marshall Fine Art Editions cannot accept responsibility for the security of information you send to, or receive from us over the Internet or for any unauthorized access or use of that information.
